

#### First Equipment you will need!

#### Keep calm and conscious

- Contain it
- Solve it

#### **Basic Needs**




It's better to solve it while you're working with bi-plane fluoroscopic system.





#### Need a large, long recovery sheath

- At least 85 cm length.
- 2-3 Fr. larger than the original sheath diameter.
- · Ability to shape, kink resistance.
- Bleed-back valve/ Y-adaptor.



#### **Amplatz Goose-Neck<sup>™</sup> Snare**

(Microvena, ev3)



- Nitinol wire loop (shape memory).
- Open in fix diameter in 90°
- 5 to 35 mm diameter.
- 4Fr catheter for 5-10 mm.
- Micro-snare is also available from 2-7 mm in diameter.
- Snare length 65 and 120 mm.
- Catheter length 48 and 102 mm.





#### **Amplatz Goose-Neck<sup>™</sup> Snare**

(Microvena, ev3)



- Nitinol wire loop (shape memory).
- Open in fix diameter in 90°
- 5 to 35 mm diameter.
- 4Fr catheter for 5-10 mm.
- Micro-snare is also available from 2-7 mm in diameter.
- Snare length 65 and 120 mm.
- Catheter length 48 and 102 mm.







#### **EN Snare**<sup>™</sup>

(Merit Medical)

- 3 Nitinol wire loops.
- Diameter from 2 45 mm.
- Length 175 cm (or 2-8 mm) and 120 cm (for the rest)
- Catheter size 3.2 to 7 Fr.




## **Endovascular snare. Good for side wall object.**



#### Multi-snare<sup>™</sup>




- Double loop configure
- 5- 30 mm snare diameter (micro set is also available)
- 4-6 Fr carrier catheter (125 cm length)
- 15 mm snare length


#### **Expro**<sup>™</sup> Elite Snare

(Radius Medical Technologies)




- 0.035" profile.
- 2 helical loop wires.
- Loop diameter 5,10,15,25,35 mm.






## Curry<sup>TM</sup> Intravascular Retrieval Set (Cook)



## Welter™ retrieval loop

(Cook)


- 5Fr, braided catheter, tapered to 4Fr non braidedsegment at distal end.
- Retrieve object by opening up loop wire at the catheter's tip.




## The Needle Eye<sup>™</sup> Snare

(Cook)

- Made from shape-retentive alloy.
- 12 Fr. carrier catheter.
- Need 14 Fr. long sheath.
- Design for pacemaker lead extraction.
- Strongest retrieval system.





## **Baskets**

#### **Baskets**

- Borrow from urologist and gastroenterologist.
- 3-5 fine strands of wire attached together.
- Needs 3-4 Fr larger than the carrier catheter for the basket device.




#### Medi-tech<sup>TM</sup> retrieval basket (Boston Scientific)

- Spiral basket
- Diameter 15 or 25 mm.
- 5Fr carrier catheter.
- 120 and 150 cm length.

#### Segura basket<sup>TM</sup> (Boston Scientific)

- 4 flat wires.
- 16 and 20 mm diameter.
- 4.5 and 7Fr carrier catheter with
   70 cm length.



#### **Baskets**

- Borrow from urologist and gastroenterologist.
- 3-5 fine strands of wire attached together.
- Needs 3-4 Fr larger than the carrier catheter for the basket device.




#### Medi-tech<sup>TM</sup> retrieval basket (Boston Scientific)


- 4 flat wires.


- Bioptome forceps (6-7 Fr.)

- Vascular retrieval forceps. (Cook)




#### Container/ Stabilizer/Back up


#### Guide Wires

- Snares


